1. Land Acknowledgement

7. **Tim Kocur, executive director of the Waterfront BIA** reports on their sponsorship of arts and activities on the Waterfront. The latest is an offer to sponsor a children's event with the help of local parents.
8. **Representative of Harbourfront Centre** plans for big crowds and special events during FIFA. HfC is an official site for FIFA, and we'll hear what will happen.
